Class Descriptions

Musical Theatre Classes (Broadway Stars)

Musical Theatre Classes offer instruction in the three areas of performance: Acting, Voice and Movement. Students are offered basic vocal training that includes proper breath support, vowel placement, tone production and microphone technique. Basic dance steps and styles will be taught as well as acting skills to give the student the opportunity to develop skills through improvisation, character development and scene study. These skills help the student in building self-esteem and confidence as they prepare for solo and ensemble work for the recital during the second half of the year.

Musical Production (Ages 13+)

This specialized Broadway musical production will be designed for performance at The Paris Cabaret. This production is open to all Academy students by audition or permission from the director. This course will require extra rehearsals leading up to the production and requires a dedicated commitment from the student. Please be prepared.

Creative Dance Program: Pre-Creative Combo (Ages 2.5-4), Creative Combo 1 (Ages 4-5) & Creative Combo 2 (Ages 5-7)

These classes are designed for the beginner dancer with the child in mind. Basic fundamentals such as motor skills, balance coordination and musicality are incorporated to help develop the student's love for dance. Most importantly keeping the child in mind is at the center of our focus during these courses using imagination through dance movements and building self-esteem to help them grow into confident individuals. Each year the course progresses and improves on skills from the previous one. All courses are filled with lots of energy and creativity to keep the child's mind and attention engaged. Also these classes are intended for children who do not need parental supervision during class.

Pre-Creative Combo is split in time between, pre ballet, tumbling, creative movement and rhythm skills

Creative Combo 1 & 2 are split in time between ballet, basic gymnastic skills, creative movement, dance games and tap.

Primary Dance Combo 1 (Ages 7 - 9): BALLET, TAP and JAZZ

These classes become more structured as the child develops an awareness of their own physical coordination and musicality. Age appropriate exercises and warm-ups are given through the subject of ballet, tap and jazz. **Students will perform two recital routines at the end of year (Genres for recital TBD)**

(Two costumes) \$72

Primary Dance Combo 2, 3, 4 (Ages 9-11), (Ages 11-13) & (Ages 13+): BALLET, TAP and JAZZ

As the dancer matures so does the class in an even more structured series of studying ballet, jazz and tap. The student will become a more independent dancer through these courses while learning valuable technique to become a great technician but even furthermore they will learn the disciplines such as self-respect, self-confidence, creativity and self-expression. This will help instill an appreciation not only for the art of dance but for one's self. The class time will be split in time between ballet, tap and jazz. We also recommend that the students in these classes take Ballet offered on Mondays or Thursdays for additional technique and training. Pointe may be taken after Ballet 2 with permission from the instructor.

Each group will perform two recital routines at the end of the year (Genres for recital TBD) (Two Costumes) Primary 2&3 \$81 Primary 4 \$86

Ballet

This class will emphasize the development of classical ballet skills with a focus on proper placement and alignment. Students will learn ballet vocabulary through barre and center work while building strength and flexibility. These are not recital classes, emphasis is strictly on technique.

Special for Ballet, \$50 monthly or \$25 flat rate with enrollment in any other Academy class

Lyrical/Contemporary Dance (Ages 13+)

This course will include elements from modern, ballet and jazz dance. Dancers will learn to express and convey emotion on an artistic level through their dancing. Must be enrolled in Ballet 1, 2 or a Primary Combo. *\$56*

Hip Hop

The spirit of hip hop is designed to develop motor coordination, strength, agility & rhythm while learning the most fundamental hip hop skills such as popping, locking & waving. Hip hop is lots of fun while instilling confidence & self-esteem. It's a very high-energy class that uses the latest sounds of rap, R&B and pop music.

Hip Hop 1: \$46 All other Hip Hop classes \$56

Drama (Acting Technique)

Classes will help to build confidence & self-esteem while instilling the love of theatre through various warm-ups and theatre games. Students will work on techniques for auditions; learn cold readings, stage etiquette, character development, monologues & scene study. The students will also have the opportunity to become familiar with various types of stage craft and they will prepare scenes and monologues for their end of the year show in June at the Paris Cabaret.
